- Students should not arrive on campus before 8:00 a.m. unless they are registered in our Extended Day Program.

- Use our car loop for delivery and pickup of students in a vehicle. Please do not exit your vehicle to get your child. If you need to enter the building, you may park in the parking lot and cross at the designated crosswalk area.
- Car riders should have their students' sign displayed in the window during pick-up. This helps the line move much faster. If you need another sign, please see someone in the front office.
- If your child needs to change the way they are to get home, you will need to write a note in their planner. We will not be able to accept requests over the phone.
- Students cannot be checked out for dismissal after 2:15 p.m. per DCPS Board policy.
